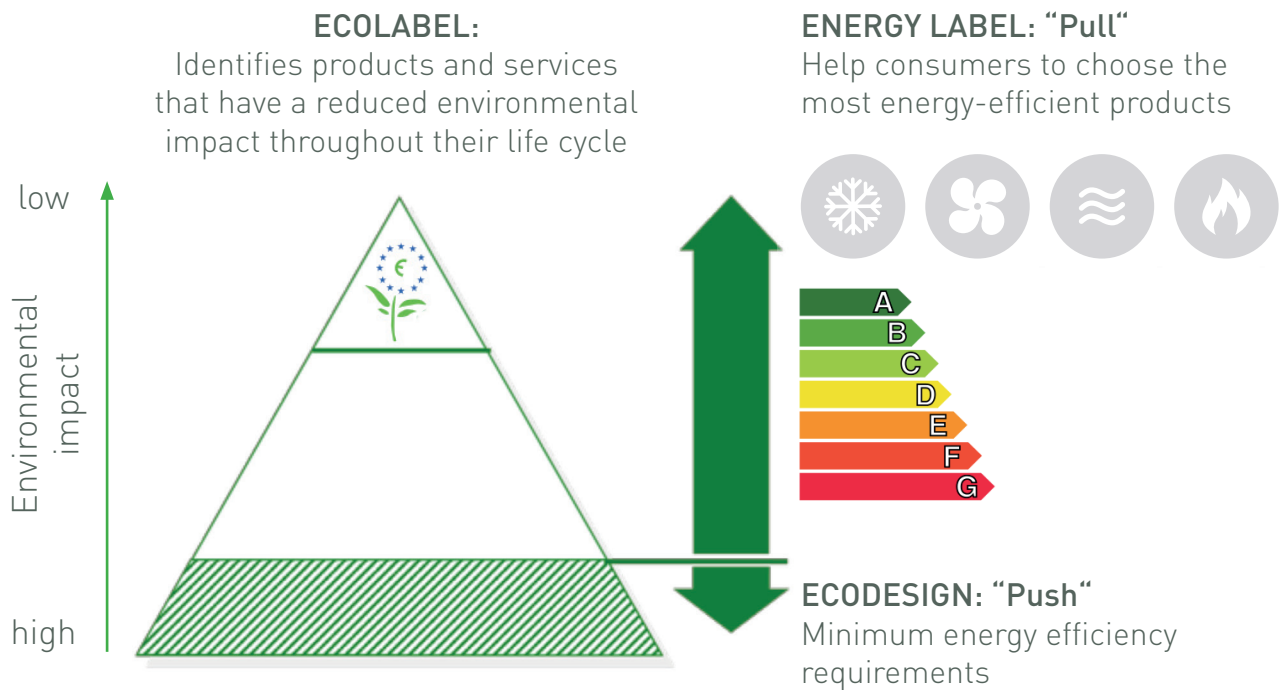

Every three years, the European Commission adopts a Working Plan, which sets out an indicative list of priority products to be explored for their ecodesign potential. The Commission is currently preparing the 2015-2017 Work Plan. EPEE members are impacted by a set of Ecodesign and Energy Labelling Regulations.
